**VILLAGE BOARD, COMMISSION & COMMITTEE  
DESCRIPTION AND MEETING SCHEDULE**

**Board of Fire & Police Commissioners – 3-Year Term (3 commissioners)**

Administers, according to state statute, personnel matters pertaining to the Oak Brook Fire and Police Departments. Responsible for testing, hiring and major disciplinary cases for both departments. Meets as needed.

**Community Enhancement Committee – 2-Year Term (chairman, secretary and 16 members)**

Provides advice and recommendations to the Village Board on priorities, changes, implementation and improvements of the Village's Commercial Revitalization/Streetscape Plans and the Village's Economic Development Program. Meets as needed.

**Firefighters Pension Fund Board –3-Year Term (2 appointments, minimum 1 resident, on a larger board)**

Oversees the investments and claims relating to firefighter pension funds. Meets quarterly, beginning in February and on call as noticed in the Upper Level Conference Room of the Butler Government Center 1200 Oak Brook Road.

**Hotel, Convention & Visitors Committee – 1-Year Term (2 residents on a larger committee)**

Recommends advertising campaigns promoting overnight stays at Oak Brook hotels. Meets on the second Thursday of the month in January, April, August & October.

**Library Commission – 3-Year Term (7 commissioners)**

Advises the Village Board regarding Library policies and services. Meets every other month on the third Tuesday beginning in January.

**Long Term Strategic Planning Advisory Committee-1-Year Term (chairman & 11 members)**

Provides advice and recommendations to the Village Board concerning economic development, housing and school district matters, Village finances, Sports Core finances, other issues as determine by the Village Board. This Committee is in place for 1-year at which time it will Sunset. Meets as needed.

**Plan Commission – 3-Year Term (chairman and 6 members)**

Oversees the implementation of the Comprehensive Plan and deals with the future of the Village in the broad sense of overall planning, subdivision, infrastructure, etc. Meets on the third Monday of each month.

**Police Pension Fund – 2-Year Term (2 residents on a larger board)**

Oversees the investments and claims relating to police pension funds. Meets quarterly beginning in January, and on call as noticed in the Upper Level Conference Room of the Butler Government Center 1200 Oak Brook Road.

**Sports Core Advisory Committee - 3-Year Term (chairman & 8 members)**

Makes recommendations to the Village Board on Sports Core amenities improvements, finances and issues which include Golf, Bath & Tennis Club and grounds. Meets as needed.

**Technology Advisory Committee - 3-Year Term (5 members)**

Provides advice and recommendations on Village technology-related goals, strategies and policies. Meets as needed.

**Zoning Board of Appeals – 5-Year Term (chairman and 6 members)**

Deals specifically with the Zoning Ordinance and its implementation and enforcement, including such things as amendments, variations and appeals. Meets on the first Tuesday of each month.
