SUBJECT: 2017 Bias Based Profiling Analysis

It is the policy of the Oak Brook Police Department to provide services to all persons without regard to race, ethnic background, gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, religion, economic status, age or cultural group.

A review of 2017 enforcement data did not reveal any pattern or trend that would indicate bias based policing.

In 2017 the Oak Brook Police Department did not receive any complaints alleging disparate treatment based on race, gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, religion, economic status, age or cultural group.

I have reviewed the 2017 traffic enforcement data provided by the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) and compared that data to the statewide average in the table below (Table 1).

On a comparative basis the stop ratio (non-white to white) of the Oak Brook Police Department is significantly less than that of the statewide average. Additionally, compared to the statewide average, non-whites were 13.2% less likely to be issued a citation by the Oak Brook Police Department.

I have compared our traffic enforcement data to previous years (2004 to 2015) and listed the percentage of change from 2016 to 2017 in the table below (Table 2).

The 2017 stop ratio increased by .23 when compared to the 2016 stop ratio. Additionally, the number of traffic citations during the same period of comparison increased for both whites (up 3.37%) and non-whites (up 3.69%).

The table below (Table 3) compares our municipality to every bordering jurisdiction and indicates the frequency at which whites and non-whites received traffic citations in 2016.

The number of traffic citations issued by the Oak Brook Police Department to non-white drivers is substantially lower than the number issued Statewide. Additionally, with the exception of the Oakbrook Terrace Police Department, the number of traffic citations issued by the Oak Brook Police Department to non-white drivers is significantly lower than the number issued by those jurisdictions surrounding the Village of Oak Brook; a range of 6.77% to 34.04% lower.

I have attached a copy of the traffic stop statistical summary for each entity referred to in this analysis.

In 2015, the Illinois General Assembly passed Public Act 99-352, which supplements the Illinois Traffic Stop Study by mandating the collection of data on certain types of pedestrian stops. In 2016, the Oak Brook Police Department report 18 pedestrian stops. The vast majority of the stops were the result of a complaint received from a member of the public. Eleven of the stops resulted in the arrest of the individual. The table below (Table 4) depicts the number of stops by race.
